Legal Agreement of Apportionment

APPORTIONMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of Basingstoke in the County of Southampton

Whereas an Agreement for the COMMUTATION OF TITHES in the Parish of Basingstoke in the County of Southampton, was on the Sixteenth day of June in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule hereunto annexed, the following is a Copy:-

Provisional Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of Tithes in the Parish of Basingstoke in the County of Southampton in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden in the said Parish and holden by adjournment on the Twenty eighth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and since perfected by and between the several persons Owners of Land within the said Parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorized in that behalf these presents are executed and the Interest of Landowners in the lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to Tithes of the one part and the President and Scholars of Magdelen College Oxford, Impropriate Rectors of the said Parish and The Reverend James Blatch Vicar of the said Parish which said Impropriator Rectors and Vicar are as such respectively Owners of all the Tithes as well areat as small thereof of the other part.

It is hereby agreed that the Annual Sum of Seven hundred and eighty three Pounds and seven shillings by way of Rent Charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said President and Scholars as such Rectors as aforesaid and to their successors instead of all the Rectorial Tithes of all the Lands of the said Parish (exclusive of the Rectorial Tithe of the Glebe Land in the Schedule hereunder written mentioned the Rent Charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Two Pounds and fourteen shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe Lands and also Tithe in respect of certain Land in the Schedule hereunder written mentioned situate in the said Parish but which is part and parcel of the Glebe Lands of the Parish of Basing in the said County the Rent Charge in lieu of the Rectorial Tithe thereof it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the Sum of One Pound and which Item it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively on the last mentioned Glebe Land and instead of all Moduses Compositions real or prescriptive or customary payments heretofore payable to the said Impropriators in respect of the Lands of the said Parish of Basingstoke.

And it further agreed that the annual Sum of Four hundred and ninety four Pounds and thirteen shillings by way of Rent Charge (subject to the provisions of the said Act) shall be paid to the said James Blatch as Vicar of the said Parish and to his successors instead of all the Vicarial Tithes of the Lands of the said Parish (exclusive of the Vicarial Tithe of the said Glebe Land of the said Parish in the Schedule hereunder written mentioned the Rent Charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the Sum of Two Pounds and ten shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe Land and also Tithes in respect of the Glebe Land parcel of the said Glebe Lands of the Parish of Basing aforesaid and herein before mentioned the Rent Charge in lieu of Vicarial Tithes thereof it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Eight shillings and which item it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the last mentioned Glebe Lands) and instead of all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable to the Vicar as such in respect of all the Lands of the said Parish a summary description of which Lands is contained in the Schedule hereunder written.

And it is hereby further agreed that the Lands included in this agreement shall be discharged from the payment of Tithes from the First day of October next preceeding the Confirmation of the apportionment of the Rent Charges hereinbefore agreed on and that the first payment of such Rent Charges herein before agreed on shall be made or be recoverable on the First day of April then next.

In testimony whereof the said Parties to these presents or their respective agents thereunto duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have to these presents subscribed and set their respective hands and seals:-

Schedule to the above Articles of Agreement.

The whole Parish of Basingstoke contains Four thousand two hundred and fifty one acres one rood and thirty six perches by The whole quantity of the Lands of the said Parish which is subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is Three thousand nine hundred and forty four acres by estimation.

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as Arable Land is Three thousand five hundred and thirty two acres by estimation.

The whole quantity of Lands subject to Tithes within the said Parish cultivated as Meadow or Pasture Land is Three hundred and fortyone acres by estimation.

The whole quantity of Lands subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as Wood Lland is Fifty two acres by estimation.

The Glebe Lands of the said Parish belonging to the Impropriate Rectors thereof which if not in the hands of the Owner or Owners would be subject to Rectorial Tithes amounts to Twelve acres and five perches by estimation.

The Vicarial Glebe Lands of the said Parish which if not in the hands of the Owner or Owners would be subject to Vicarial Tithes amounts to One acre and three roods by estimation.

The Glebe Land being part and Parcel of the Glebe Land of the Parish of Basing in the said County but which is situate within this Parish contains Five Acres one rood and six perches by estimation.

The sites of Buildings contain One hundred and fifty acres by estimation.

The Gardens which have not hereto before paid Tithes and which are exempt by prescription contain Twenty acres by estimation.

The Roads and Waste Lands in the said Parish of Basingstoke contain thirty acres by estimation.

The Common known as Basingstoke Common within the said Parish and which under and by virtue of a certain Act of Parliament of the Twenty sixth year of his late Majesty King George the third intitled an Act for dividing allotting and inclosing the open and Common Fields common Downs common pastures Common Meadows Waste Lands and other commonable places within the Parish of Basingstoke is exempt from the render of all manner of Tithes contains One hundred and seven acres one rood and twenty five perches by estimation.

Now We Charles Osborn of Fareham and Thomas Hasker of Basingstoke in the County of Southampton having been duly appointed Valuers to apportion the Total Sum awarded to be paid by way of Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes amongst the several Lands of the said Parish of Basingstoke.

Do hereby apportion the Rent Charge as follows:-
