Legal Agreement of Apportionment

APPORTIONMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of Mappledurwell in the County of Southampton

Whereas an Agreement for the COMMUTATION OF TITHES in the Parish of Mappledurwell in the County of Southampton, was on the Tenth day of October in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty nine, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule thereunto annexed, the following is a Copy:-

Provisional Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of Tithes in the Parish of Mappledurwell in the County of Southampton in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden in the said Parish and adjourned from time to time and holden by adjournment on the twenty ninth day of November in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and since perfected By and Between the several persons Owners of Land in the said Parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorized in that behalf these presents are executed and the interest of Landowners in the Lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to Tithes of the one part and The Reverend Richard Hunter rector of the said Parish and Owner of all the tithes as well great as small thereof of the other part.

It is hereby agreed that the annual sum of Two Hundred and Twenty Pounds by way of Rent Charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said Richard Hunter as Rector of the said Parish and to his Successors instead of all the Tithes as well great as small of the lands of the said Parish (exclusive of the Tithe of Glebe the Rent charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Two Pounds and in respect of the Great Tithes of all the Glebe Lands of the said Parish and One Pound in respect of the small Tithes of the Glebe lands of the said Parish and which items it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe Lands) and instead of all Moduses Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of all the Lands of the said Parish or the produce thereof a summary description of which Lands is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

And it is hereby lastly agreed that the several Rent Charges hereinbefore mentioned shall be payable from the first day of October next preceding the confirmation of the Apportionment thereofoand that all and singular the Lands included in the foregoing agreement shall be thenceforth discharged from the payment of Tithes both Great and Small.

In testimony whereof the said parties to these presents or their respective agents thereunto duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have to these presents subscribed and set their hands and seals:-

#### Schedule to the above Articles of Agreement.

The whole Parish of Mappledurwell aforesaid contains by estimation, Seven Hundred and ninety six acres of Land Statute Measure.

The whole Quantity of the Lands of the said Parish which are subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is by estimation Six Hundred and thirty seven acres Statute Measure.

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as arable Land is by estimation Five Hundred and Eighty acres Statute measure.

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish cultivated as Meadow and Pasture Land is by estimation Thirty six acress Statute Measure.

The whole quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish cultivated as Woodland is by estimation Twenty acres Statute measure.

The whole Quantity of Common Land not subject to Tithes within the said Parish is by estimation One Hundred acres Statute measure exempt by prescription.

The Glebe Lands of the said Parish which if not in the hands of the Owner would be subject to Tithe amount by estimation to Eight acres and three roods, the whole of which belong to the said Richard Hunter as such Rector of Mappledurwell aforesaid.

Now I Charles Headeach of Basingstoke in the County of Southampton having been duly appointed Valuer to apportion the Total Sum agreed to be paid by way of Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes amongst the several Lands of the said Parish of Mappledurwell

Do hereby apportion the Rent Charge as follows:
