Legal Agreement of Apportionment

Agreement

APPORTIONMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of Nately Scures in the County of Southampton

Whereas an Agreement for the COMMUTATION OF TITHES in the Parish of Nately Scures in the County of Southampton, was on the thirty first day of Ocober in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty nine, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule thereunto annexed, the following is a Copy:-

Provisional Articles of Agreement for the commutation of Tithes of the Parish of Nately Scures in the County of Southampton in pursuance of an Act for the commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a meeting called and holden in the said Parish and adjourned and holden by adjournment on the Twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and since perfected by and between the several persons owners of Land within the said Parish by whom or by whose agents duly authorized in that behalf these presents are executed and the Interest of which Landowners in the lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the lands therein subject to Tithes of the one part and The Honorable and Reverend Richard Carleton Rector of the said Parish and owner of all the Tithes thereof of the other part.

It is hereby agreed that the annual sum of Two hundred and fifteen Pounds by way of Rent charge (subject to the provisions of the said Act) shall be paid to the said Richard Carleton Rector of the said Parish and to his successors instead of all the Tithes of all the landssubject to Tithes (exclusive of the Tithe of Glebe the Rent charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of Three Pounds and which item it is agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe Land) and instead of all Moduses and compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of all the lands of the said Parish or the produce thereof a Summary description of which lands is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

In testimony whereof the said Parties to these presents or their respective Agents thereunto duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have to these presents subscribed and set their respective hands and seals:-

The whole Parish of Nately Scures contains Nine hundred and ninety four acres by estimation.

The whole quantity of the land of the said Parish which are subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is Seven hundred and sixteen acres by estimation.

The whole quantity of land subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as Arable Land is (by estimation) Five hundred and forty four acres.

The whole Quantity of land subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as Meadow or Pasture Land is One hundred and fifteen acres by estimation.

The whole Quantity of Land subject to Tithes within the said Parish now cultivated as Wood Land is forty five Acres by estimation.

The Glebe Lands of the said Parish which if not in the hands of the owner or owners would be subject to Tithes amount to twelve Acres by estimation.

The Waste Common Roads Cottage Gardens Churchyard and site of buildings is Two hundred and seventy eight acres by estimation.
