Legal Agreement of Apportionment

APPORTIONMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of North Waltham in the County of Southampton

Whereas an Agreement for the COMMUTATION of TITHES in the Parish of North Waltham in the County of Southampton was, on the thirtieth day of April in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty nine, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement, with the Schedule hereunto annexed, the following is a copy:-

Provisional Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of the tithes in the parish of North Waltham in the County of Southampton in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden in the said Parish and adjourned and holden by adjournment on the twenty first day of June in the year One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and since perfected By and Between the several Bodies Politic and persons Owners of Land within the said parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorized in that behalf these presents are executed and the interest of which Landowners in the Lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to tithes of the one part and the Reverend William Frazer Clerk Rector of the said Parish and as such Owner of all the tithes as well areat as small thereof of the other part.

It is hereby agreed that the annual sum of Four hundred and ten pounds by way of Rent charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said William Fraser as Rector of the said Parish and to his successors instead of all the tithes as well great as small of the lands of the said parish subject to tithes including tithe of Glebe the Rent charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the sum of twenty pounds in respect of the Rectorial or great tithes and also in respect of the Vicarial or small tithes of the Glebe of the said parish and which item it is hereby agreed shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe lands a summary description of which lands is contained in the Schedule hereunder written.

And it is further agreed that the Rent charge herebefore mentioned shall be payable from the first day of October next preceding the confirmation of the apportionment thereof and that all the lands included in the foregoing Agreement shall be thenceforth discharged from the payment of tithes.

In Witness whereof the said parties to this Agreement or their Agents duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have hereunto subscribed and set their respective hands and seals at the respective times hereupon indorsed.

Schedule to the above Articles of Agreement.

The whole of the Parish of North Waltham aforesaid contains by estimation One thousand seven hundred and ninety five acres of land statute measure including ninety acres of Glebe lands, the whole of which land is subject to payment in kind of all manner of tithes as well great as small.

The whole quantity of land subject to tithes within the said parish which is cultivated as Arable land is by estimation One thousand four hundred and seventy acres Statute measure.

The whole quantity of land subject to tithes within the said parish which is cultivated as Meadow or Pasture land is by estimation Ninety five acres Statute measure.

The whole quantity of land subject to tithes within the said parish which is cultivated as Wood land is by estimation Two hundred and thirty acres Statute measure.

No Modus or composition, real or prescriptive or customary payment is payable instead of all or any of the tithes of the said Parish.

Now I Charles Osborn of Fareham in the County of Southampton having been duly appointed Valuer to apportion the Total Sum agreed to be paid by way of Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes, amongst the several lands of the said Parish of North Waltham.

Do hereby apportion the Rent Charge as follows:

Gross Rent Charge payable to the Titheowner in lieu of Tithes for the Parish of North Waltham in the County of Southampton, Four hundred and ten Pounds.
